Purpose of Role

Assist and manage Operation for Curzon Facilities/Maintenance Department at Curzon Cinemas, across London sites. Reporting to Head of Technical and Facilities.

Role Responsibilities

- To provide effective support to the Head of Technical and Facilities, to provide advice or guidance where appropriate
- To undertake training if required, and to be able to deal with maintenance problems that may arise within the company.
- To reduce the need for external contractors
- To be responsible for maintenance and good housekeeping.
- To report any Maintenance issues to the appropriate team and share information.
- To facilitate the successful management and implementation of all H&S requirements e.g. audits and their follow up, risk assessments, and general on-site management.
- To ensure training and knowledge is always up to date and risks are assessed and controlled at all times.
- To escalate H&S or licencing issues to the General Manager and Head of Technical and Facilities.
- To be responsible for the operation and first line maintenance of all areas within the Cinema.
- To oversee any third-party contractors that may be working within the building, making sure that all H&S guidelines are being kept.
- To understand the function of all mechanical plant within the building.
- To assist with any first line site maintenance that effects the operational running of the site.
- To liaise with any on site contractors requiring support or assistance.
- To provide appropriate cover and support for the business across all trading days. This may include some 'on call' support as required.
- To undertake any other ad-hoc maintenance related tasks or any other reasonable request that falls within the remit of the job.

Skills and knowledge required to perform role

- Experience of facilities department, plumbing and electrical
- Good numerical and analysing skills.
- Good IT skills.
- Good DIY skills.
- Knowledge/enthusiasm and passion for films
- Has a good knowledge of the industry and keeps up to date with relevant advancements and or development.
- The ability to communicate and influence others using the appropriate communication style in a credible, diplomatic, concise and confident manner.
- The ability to accomplish tasks by paying full attention to all areas.
- Able to anticipate, identify and take action to exceed guest expectations.
- The ability to perform effectively under pressure and in the face of adversity and/or tight deadlines.
- The ability to carry out tasks using own initiative.
- Ability to lead and work effectively within a team, share information and value the input of others.
- A willingness to work flexible hours as required, including occasional overnight stays near sites where necessary.
- An ability to travel easily between all sites (existing and forthcoming developments).
